# Challenges faced by schools/libraries

#### Scenario

New arrivals start school/join library/community groups

They speak 10 different languages – for example Arabic, Albanian, Bulgarian, Farsi, Kurdish, Mandarin, Spanish, Romanian, Turkish or Urdu

There is no multilingual teacher/support staff/librarian who speaks their languages

What do you do?

### **Possible solutions**

- Support from interpreter/bilingual parent/peers who speak the language
- Provide bilingual books with CRPEN to enable children to hear stories in their home language and then help them access English/German/Swedish...
- Group Activities to engage, inspire all children



## Suggestions for Multilingual Storytelling

*Possible Solution – a multilingual approach to storytelling* 

A progressive route to engage and retain excitement by using Mantra Lingua tools

- Take one story *Lima's Red Hot Chilli*
- Hand out 10 language editions of *Lima's Red Hot Chilli*
- Read out the story in English (or German or Swedish), and listen in 10 home languages with CRPEN.
- Download free storyboards for children to colour/cut into cards for sequencing game
- Children record words/their story with Recordable Labels
